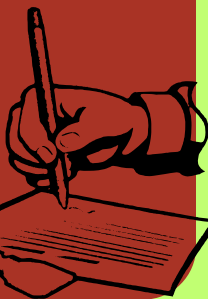


English & Tamil Handwriting Competition

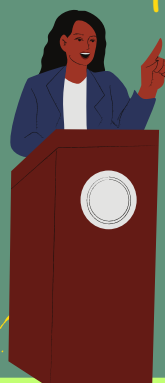


English Elocution Competition

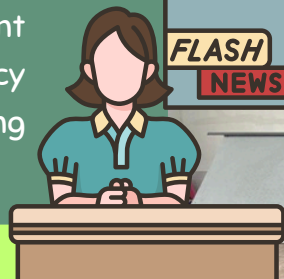

Short poem Competition

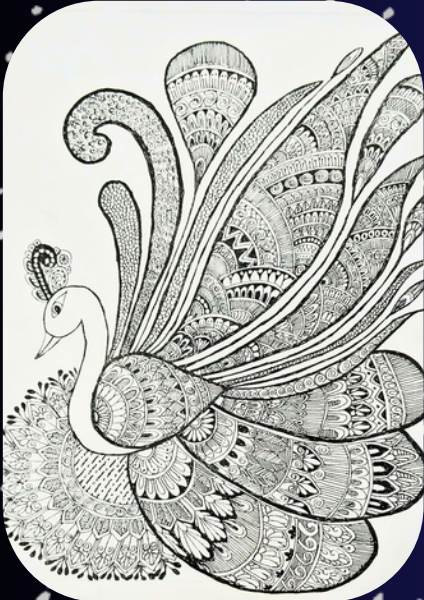
June 29, 2024

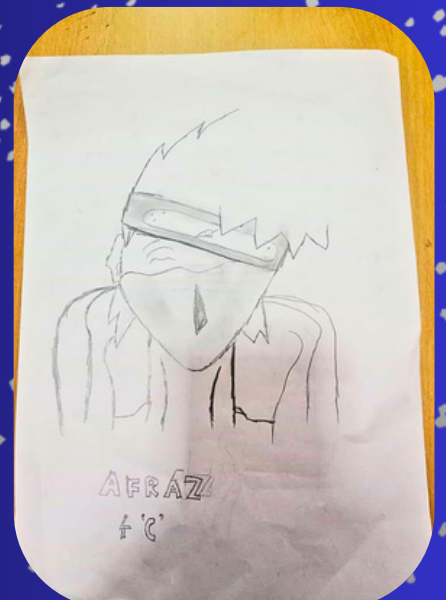

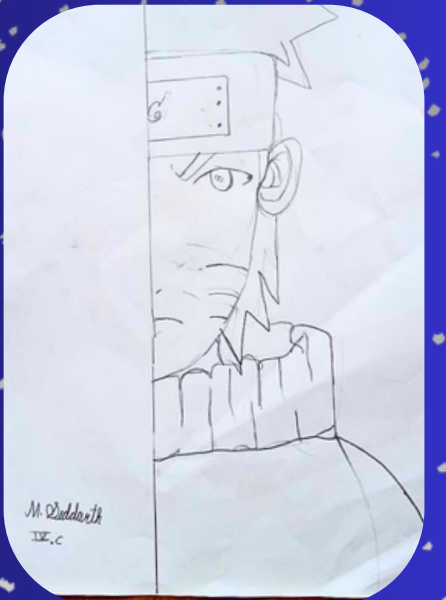

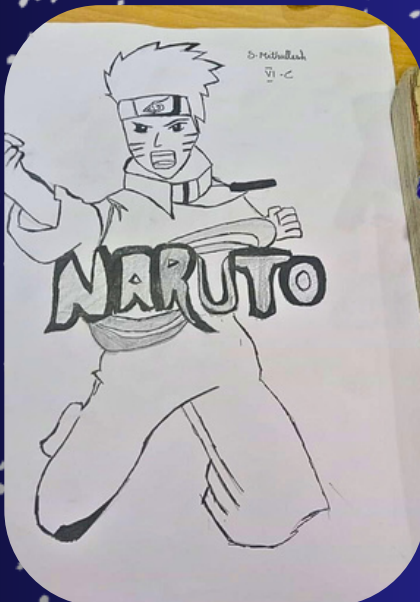
